## Inclement Weather Policy

Because this program makes use of a pontoon boat, we are at the mercy of the weather. The boat will be restricted from going out on the water should the winds be too high (20 knots or more) or should there be lightning and/or heavy rain. Please read over the weather restrictions and cancellation details below:

Light rain and weather that will not restrict use of the pontoon boat.	Field trip as scheduled.	None.	No prior communication will be made.
Weather conditions that will restrict the use of the pontoon boat but permit other activities.	Field trip as scheduled.	None.	Field collection activities will take place dockside or at the water's edge. No prior communication will be made.
Extenuating circumstances on the part of the school.	Cancellation of field trip for the day. Decision made by the school.	100% refund to the school if cancellation is made seven (7) days or more in advance of scheduled trip, or reschedule if possible.  - or -  Refund less \$50.00 to the school if cancellation is made 1-6 days in advance of scheduled trip or reschedule if possible.  - or -  Reschedule if possible.  (No refunds for cancellations on the day of the trip.)	The field trip's point-of-contact is responsible for contacting the A.C.L.E.C.
Other situations.	To be handled on a case-by-case basis.	To be determined on a case-by-case basis.	It will be the field trip's point-of-contact's responsibility to communicate questions, concerns, and other pertinent information to the A.C.L.E.C.
